PULL STARTS: 6:00 P.M./ENTRY FEE \$25.00-Admits driver and one crew member to pits. All other pit passes \$20.00 per person

Weigh in at fairgrounds 3:00-5:00 pm. Scale closes at 5:00 P.M. SHARP!

2 Eliminators NO Alcoholic Beverages allowed in pits

Tractors will be weighed on the Fair Grounds infield. Scale closes at 5:00 pm sharp — NO tractors will be weighed in after 5:00 pm. **Classes L & M will need to be weighed on Rio Creeks Scale. Instructions will be given by registration or scale personal the day of the event.** Prizes: 1st \$100, 2nd \$50, 3rd \$25, Trophies for first place plus ribbons per class. All prizes and awards must be picked up in the infield of the racetrack within 30 minutes after the event or they will be donated to the Kewaunee County 4H. Pit entrance will be off of Frontier Road on the back side of the pulling track. Take highway 54, turn south on 4th street (by Salmons Meats), Then right on Frontier Street.

No tractors or trucks will enter the pits through the Main or 4th street gates. RULES & REGULATIONS for STOCK FARM TRACTORS.

• Class B	Up to 5,500 LBS	4 MPH Speed Limit
• Class C	Up to 6,500 LBS	4 MPH Speed Limit
• Class D	Up to 8,500 LBS	4 MPH Speed Limit
• Class E	Up to 10,500 LBS	6 MPH Speed Limit
• Class F	Up to 6,000 LBS	NO Speed Limit
• Class G	Up to 8,600 LBS	12 MPH Speed Limit
• Class H	Up to 12,500 LBS	6 MPH Speed Limit
• Class I	Up to 13,000 LBS	14 MPH Speed Limit
• Class J	Up to 13,500 LBS	8 MPH Speed Limit
• Class K	Up to 17,000 LBS	8 MPH Speed Limit
• Class L	Up to 30,000 LBS	4X4 ONLY!! NO DUALS!!
• Class M	Up to 35,000 LBS	4X4 ONLY!! NO DUALS!!
• Class N	Up to 10500 LBS	Open No Speed limit, See Safety Equipment rule 7.

Rules

1. Class A-K, and N Hitch height 20"
2. Class L & M Hitch height 21" Factory Ballast ONLY. No Concrete Blocks!!!
3. Opening in hitch must be at least 3" wide and 3.75" long.
4. All Engine RPM must be within 10% of factory setting.
5. Fenders required
6. All Tractors may only enter into ONE class. Any questions call Todd Koss at 920-255-3303. These rules are set up to give every tractor entered an honest and fair chance of placing in its class. Do not try to abuse these rules to gain a competitive advantage. This show will run on time and will not wait for you. For the courtesy of the paying audience, delays will not be tolerated.

7. **Safety Equipment Required for Class N:** Clutch and turbo intake blanket. Side Shields of .060, Deadman throttle, Fuel shut off, Air shut off. Exhaust cross, Roll cage or roll bar with at least a 4-point harness, latter bars and front skis, fire extinguisher, wheely bars 10 in off the ground and must extend 2 " behind the back wheels, Helmet and Fire coat also required.
